All three wines have screw cap closures, and are wonderful Spatleses. The 2020 Klaus is a supple, light bodied wine that is ripely flavored (honeysuckle, white peach, apple), balanced, and medium long on the finish. An excellent wine that drinks well now, but can develop further.

The 2020 Berg Rottland is delicious: very ripely flavored (apple, peach, apricot, pineapple), medium rich, and nicely balanced, with a long finish. Great value; although drinking well now, it warrants further aging. 7.3% R.S. AP #014. VDP. Grosse Lage.

The 2021 Berg Rottland is exceptional; a vibrant, intensely flavored Riesling (honey, peach, honeysuckle) that is medium sweet, crisp, and long and persistent on the finish.
